


Different relationships provide different things

Illustrative Example




Increase in relationship duration and intensity

Psycho a set back, but recovery under way




You rank highly among existing relationships



Avg. time spent on relationship per week


Relationship drivers

Greatest gap in sex, shopping





- Parent


"I thought he was gay"
